



Notice of Intent to Apply for the Nita M. Lowey 21st Century Community Learning Centers Grant – Cycle 13

Boys & Girls Clubs of Greater Houston (BGCCH) hereby provides public notice of its intent to apply for funding under the Nita M. Lowey 21st Century Community Learning Centers (21st CCLC) Grant, Cycle 13. This federal program, administered in Texas by the Texas Education Agency, supports the creation of community learning centers that provide academic enrichment opportunities during non-school hours for students, particularly those who attend high-poverty and low-performing schools.

Through this application, BGCCH seeks to expand high-quality, research-based out-of-school-time programming that advances academic support, youth development, and family engagement. Proposed services could include homework help and tutoring; project-based learning; enrichment in STEM, literacy, the arts, and opportunities that build social skills, leadership, and workforce readiness for youth.

If awarded, BGCCH will implement programs in partnership with a local school district and community stakeholders to ensure safe, accessible, and developmentally appropriate learning environments for students and their families. All program sites, schedules, and services will be communicated broadly to the public following award announcements.
